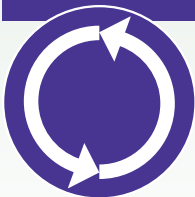
Our community partners fall into one of three categories:

CONNECTOR — Partner Recognition/Coordinated Activities (short-term focus)



Community-based organizations, local businesses, faith-based organizations, and individuals in our community have the opportunity to partner with our Schools. These partnerships may include a one-time donation of time (volunteering), supplies/materials, and/or a monetary donation. These donations may or may not be tied to the building's School Improvement Plan.

SUSTAINER — Financial/Intellectual Services (short or long-term)



Community-based organizations, local businesses, faith-based organizations, and individuals in our community have the opportunity to become Community Sustainers with our schools. Community Sustainers have ongoing partnerships with one or more schools. They make donations of their time (volunteering), supplies/materials, and/or monetary donations. These partners and the schools collaborate to strengthen the assets of the school and meet the needs of the school as identified in the School Improvement Plan.

LEAD INNOVATOR — Significant Level of Integration



Community-based organizations, local businesses, faith-based organizations, and individuals in our community have the opportunity to become Community Lead Innovators with our schools. Lead Innovators have on-going partnerships with one or more schools. They make ongoing donations of their time (volunteering), supplies/materials, and/or monetary donations. This may involve contract services and agreements between the Innovator and the District. Efforts are aligned with the building-based improvement plans and the GCSD Strategic Framework. Entities are dependent upon one another for the success of the identified goals.
