# NEW VISIONS IS:

A one-year career exploration program that provides highly motivated seniors with the opportunity to gain valuable insights into career options from a real-world perspective.

Area businesses, colleges, health care and government facilities provide the setting for immersed learning in a career field of interest to the student.

Students have the opportunity to:

- Network with industry professionals
- Participate in job shadowing
- Earn high school and college credits

New Visions classes meet from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. When students are not shadowing in a professional location, they are in classrooms located at SUNY Brockport, an MCC satellite campus or in the same complexes as shadowing locations.

New Visions is the only senior year educational experience that provides a full year of real world career immersion.

# CAREER EXPLORATION INCLUDES:

- Shadowing professionals
- Participating in industry tours and field trips
- Interviewing professionals in the field
- Engaging with guest speakers
- Professional networking
- Developing mentoring contacts



### IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

- New Visions is a career exploration program. It is not a skills training program.
- New Visions students have the opportunity to shadow professionals. The program is not an internship. Students do not provide services to clients or patients.
- Students with a pre-determined professional goal will be assigned to a variety of careers to experience the interconnectedness between occupations.
- There is an application and acceptance process required for all New Visions students.





Students earn 3 high school credits for New Visions

- $\Rightarrow$  1 credit for Government/Economics
- $\Rightarrow$  2 elective credits

Students can earn dual enrollment credit for college courses

- $\Rightarrow$  Students in Health Professions enroll in HED 130-Foundations of Personal Health and Wellness
- ⇒ Students in Justice Professions enroll in CRJ 101-Intro to Criminal Justice and CRJ 121- Criminal Justice Education Intern

College dual enrollment options may include:

- $\Rightarrow$  Economics 101
- $\Rightarrow$  Small Group Communication 143

# ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- College-bound high school juniors with interest in the career field represented by the New Visions class
- Academic requirements:
- ⇒Completion of 3 years of Regents math and Regents science
- ⇒A score of 76 or higher on the ELA Regents exam
- $\Rightarrow$ A score of 85 or higher on the Geometry Regents <u>OR</u> 70 or higher on the Algebra 2 Regents
- No behavior, attendance or discipline concerns during junior year
- Able to successfully complete industry requirements for placement, which may include a background check, drug test and/or vaccinations
