The Greece Central School District serves most of the Town of Greece. The Greece Central School District was created in July 1928, but schools existed in the area before the Town was established in 1822.



# STATE OF THE ART **FACILITIES**

In 2020, the Greece CSD invested over \$100.000.000 to remodel, rebuild, and revitalize buildings, athletic school facilities, and our technology infrastructure. The Reimagine Greece Capital Improvement Plan brought synthetic football and baseball/softball fields to our 4 high schools, in addition to a brand new transportation and technology facility. also have updated the Greece Athena Performing Arts Center. The 66,753 squarefoot facility is the largest and most technologically advanced of any school in the county.
